## Seeking Clear Administrative Services Credential Candidates & Coaches

The Los Angeles New Administrators Leadership Program is a two-year, competency-based leadership development program that leads to a Clear Administrative Services Credential (Tier II) for administrators who have a Preliminary Administrative Services Credential (Tier I) in LAUSD's autonomous schools (Pilot, School-Based Management, Local Initiative) and other LAUSD schools. Along with support from the LANALP staff and an experienced Coach, new administrators of elementary and secondary schools will be prepared to think systemically and act strategically so that they can empower a leadership team that will positively impact instructional quality and student achievement. Tuition for the first four cohorts is provided through a federal grant from the U.S. Department of Education. Coaches are offered a \$3,000 stipend per year.

#### **Minimum Eligibility:**

#### Candidates: (Seeking Clear Administrative Services Credential)

- Completed a Preliminary Administrative Services Credential.
- Must be currently working as an administrator in the Los Angeles Unified School District.
- Complete an online application including submission of three references.
- Complete an in-person interview with LANALP Staff.
- Agree to a two-year induction program which will include direct support from a Coach, reflections and self-assessment, an
  Individualized Induction Plan, workshops on theory and practice, a cohort model, an action-based field project, and a cumulative
  portfolio.

#### Coaches:

- Coach must have completed a Tier I and a Tier II Administrative Services Credential.
- Have five years of administrative experience.
- Complete an online application including submission of three references.
- Attend a LANALP Selection Day Interview.
- Agree to attend a 3-day LANALP Coach Training which will blend the Cognitive Coaching, Coaching for Equity, and Adaptive Schools models.
- Agree to attend a 3-hour Program Training which will include an overview of programmatic materials and requirements.
- Agree to attend ongoing Coach Support Meetings (4-6 per year).
