1. PERSONAL ESSAY

Prepare a one/two page typed personal essay that includes the following:

- Career goal(s) and what influenced your choice of this/these goal(s).
- · Personal experiences that have helped shape your life.
- College attendance and why it is important to you.
- Financial need

2. LIST OF SCHOOL EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES/SERVICE; COMMUNITY SERVICE; AND WORK EXPERIENCE

- For school extracurricular activities and service, list programs and activities you
 have participated in on campus such as student government, athletics, publications,
 art/music/drama, interest clubs, service clubs, etc. Indicate time involved with each
 activity, length of participation, any leadership positions. For school service, include
 specific activities such as tutoring, campus beautification, assisting teachers, before and
 after school volunteer activities, etc.
- <u>For community service activities</u>, include those that have been significant for you such as hospital volunteer, tutor, charity organization(s), assisting the homeless, political activities, etc. Indicate time involved with each activity, length of participation, and leadership responsibilities.
- For work experience, include key examples of your experiences during your school years.
- <u>Honors and Awards</u>: Conclude your list with the honors and awards you have received both at school and in the community.

3. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

• An official transcript that includes senior year fall semester marks is required. The transcript, to be official, must be in a sealed envelope marked "official."

4. RECOMMENDATION

 One personal recommendation from a school counselor, teacher, or administrator on school letterhead paper is required.
